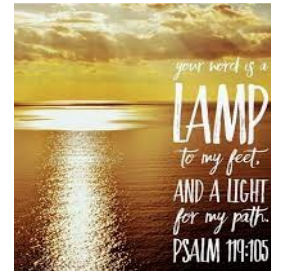

Toys in school

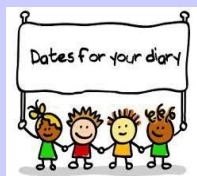
